The Greene County School Board of Education held a work session on March 13, 2019 in the Administrative Building Conference Room. President Mark Peters called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m. Directors Mike Dennhardt, Steve Fisher, Sam Harding, John McConnell, Catherine Wilson; Superintendent Tim Christensen and Board Secretary Brenda Muir were all present. Steve Karber was absent.

Harding made and Fisher seconded a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 6-0.

“Maggie”, a representative from the Puppy Jake Foundation gave a presentation. Puppy Jake trains service dogs, particularly for veterans.

Representatives from Iowa Jobs for America’s Graduates, presented information on their program. It is a worked based learning program which could expand upon what we are now offering.

Allowing the FFA to farm the property south of where the new High School/Career Academy will be under construction was discussed. Director Steve Fisher has been working with Katie Akers, Ag Ed Teacher and Tanner Lawton on a plan for this. There will be 22.9 acres available to farm in the 2019 crop year.

Superintendent Tim Christensen gave a presentation on the 2019-2020 certified budget.
