

Greene County Community School District  
Board of Education  
Special Meeting  
April 29, 2019

The Greene County School Board of Education held a special session on April 29, 2019 in the Administrative Building Conference Room. President Mark Peters called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m. Directors Mike Dennhardt, Steve Fisher, Steve Karber, John McConnell, Catherine Wilson; Superintendent Tim Christensen and Board Secretary Brenda Muir were all present. Director Sam Harding arrived after agenda approval.

McConnell made and Karber seconded a motion to approve the agenda, after amending it by adding “Resignations” after Item V. Motion carried 6-0.

Superintendent Christensen recommended Item IV - Employment Contract Termination be tabled until the May 15, 2019 regular meeting.

Harding made and Dennhardt seconded a motion to ratify the contract between the Board and Greene County Education Association for the 2019-2020 school year. It is a one year contract with a 2.6% increase, total increased cost to the district of \$204,188. Motion carried 6-0 with Fisher abstaining.

McConnell made and Karber seconded a motion to approve the following resignations: Jeff Kienast – Bus Driver, Rona Challen – Building Technology Assistant, Lori Blumberg – Middle School Special Education Teacher. Motion carried 7-0.

Lists of teachers and coaches under contract, with the exception of Baseball, Softball and Soccer, were presented for approval. Karber made and Harding seconded a motion to approve the lists after pulling out Melanie Rechkemmer, whose contract will be considered at the May 15, 2019 regular meeting. The superintendent plans to recommend cutting that position to half time due to enrollment numbers in those classes. Motion carried 6-0, with Fisher abstaining.

President Peters adjourned the meeting at 11:38 a.m.
